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Astronomy Fans: YOU Are Invited to a Free Lecture

on Space and Time

Jim’s lecture is titled “*Space and Time*”. We are all familiar with space and time, or so we think. Einstein upended our “commonsense” concepts of them in the early 1900’s, using classical physics. But quantum mechanics has made the picture even stranger than Einstein’s, and we now have some fascinating conjectures about how space and time are actually constructed, and not just how they act.

Dr. Lynch currently holds the position of Senior Scientist Emeritus the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution. He is a Fellow of the Acoustical Society of America (ASA), and of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE). He is the former Editor-in-Chief of the IEEE Journal of Oceanic Engineering and current Editor-in-Chief of ASA Publications. He is also President of the Cape Cod Astronomical Society. Jim received his B.S. in Physics from the Stevens Institute of Technology in 1972 and his Ph.D. in Physics from the University of Texas at Austin in 1978.
